


Figure 1 - Agency view




Figure 2 - Coordinated Capacity Calculator view




Figure 3 - ENTSO-E view




Figure 4 - Market Coupling Operator view




Figure 5 - Market Participant view




Figure 6 - NEMO view




Figure 7 - Shipping Agent view




Figure 8 - TSO view




Figure 9 - National Regulatory Authority view
