

IGCC – Recap 2020

The International Grid Control Cooperation (IGCC) is the implementation project chosen by ENTSO-E in February 2016 to become the future European Platform for the imbalance netting process (IN-Platform) as defined by the guideline on electricity balancing (EB Regulation Art. 22).

Over the course of the year 2020, the IGCC Project has been the leading example showcasing a fruitful collaboration of over half of all European TSOs to comply with the EB Regulation. The number of TSOs actively participating in the imbalance netting process **has grown by 50%** (6 TSOs joined in 2020), which has led to an increase of **energy savings to almost 800 GWh per month**. Not only does this have a positive effect on the more efficient energy usage, but the additionally available aFRR capacity leads to an increase of the stability of the European electricity transmission system. We are happy to share that the IGCC Project is close to implement all requirements for the imbalance netting process and are happy to welcome Bulgaria (ESO), Greece (ADMIE) and Romania (Transelectrica) to the IGCC in the upcoming year.
