- As next steps the study results will be evaluated and discussed to make a proposal for aFRR products. Relation between specific and standard products needs further discussion. Update to be given in next BSG

mFRR and RR products

- Next steps: be as precise as possible to find agreement on FAT, min max delivery period also ramp settlement principles. Define what is possible and what not for further reduction to streamline some products.
