

CWE NRAs' position on the DE/LU-AT integration in CWE DA FB MC – Euphemia performance

- CWE NRAs were, during August '18, informed by the PCR SC on performance issues of Euphemia, evidenced by RFC acceptance test results for the DE/LU-AT Request for Change
- Performance impact: Euphemia delivery of 1st result from 100% \leq 10 min (historical) to **99,7% \leq 10 min (with DE/LU-AT split)**
- First bilateral discussions between CWE NRAs, TSOs and NEMOs revealed:
 - Impact of additional border (optimization problem)
 - Impact of LTA inclusion mechanism
 - Distinction between short-, medium- and long-term mitigation measures

- On the basis of recent information, CWE NRAs agree that:
 - The ongoing approval processes and the go-live date of the DE/LU-AT (01/10/18) split should not be affected;
 - NEMOs and TSOs are asked for short-term (pre-01 Oct) and medium-/long-term (post-01 Oct) solutions, such as:
 - check & simplification of the input parameters and the LTA inclusion mechanism;
 - governance re-design and RD & CT efforts to “*future-proof*” Euphemia for upcoming, RFCs with a significant impact
 - (...)
- CWE NRAs shall duly and transparently monitor this – and other performance issues of Euphemia – and request appropriate measures in case of a risk of decoupling
- In the meantime, improvements of FB CC methodology are still ongoing and under discussion between TSOs and NEMOs.
