

# Amprion supports dialogue on transparency

- Amprion is implementing several Market Integration projects and building interconnectors to facilitate the ever growing electricity exchange across Europe.
- Our investment in a new DE-NL tie-line proves commitment to the European Market Integration
- Amprion ensures transparency based on reliable information
- Information exchange with market parties should be a continuous dialogue. EFET's criticism is a constrictive contribution. We understand traders' requests for early-on information.
- However, the following points have to be considered, in particular when new tie-lines enter into operation:
  - Multiple SPAIC-analyses are already going beyond legal requirements. They are complex analyses in which delays of the publication cannot be completely excluded.
  - Due to many technical steps/tests close to commissioning the exact commissioning date cannot be guaranteed early in advance
- Amprion is supporting the direct dialogue to improve the information exchange processes.
- We would have considered an information on the EFET criticism ahead of the MESC meeting appropriate in order to prepare constructive answers
