Transparency

- **CWE NRAs** acknowledge **progress and developments on transparency made since 2015**, with significant efforts engaged since 2 years, and welcome **the active “monitoring” role of market parties**.
 - On the incompletely fulfilled points, CWE NRAs are following and pushing for development in close interaction with TSOs.
- **CWE NRAs urge TSOs to ensure quality of already provided data** that has to be complete, consistent and up-to-date.
- CWE NRAs welcome timely reporting on transparency issues from MPs.
- **CWE NRAs acknowledge CCG meetings and ad-hoc calls as the right framework for communication between TSOs and MPs**.
- Publication of additional information or datasets has to be carefully considered and aligned with transparency framework of Core CCR.
