



Eurelectric's views on the 70% threshold

MESC meeting 17/09/2019

70% threshold: urgent need for visibility

- CEP has set targets for the minimum quantity of cross-border capacities to be allocated to the market, with derogation and exemptions possibilities ;
- Go live for implementation is officially foreseen early 2020
- Currently, there are some political agreements in place in some regions (e.g. 20% min ram in CWE)
- At this stage, market has no visibility:
 - Action plans => linear trajectory -> what are the starting points ?
 - Derogations ?
- ACER published a guidance note on the interpretation of the threshold
- Eurelectric is hence calling for:
 - Clarity on the change in capacity calculation to expect (what will change ? When ?)
 - Ensuring a smooth transition between current and target CCM (a.o. no step back)
 - Visibility on the impacts → parallel run could be a good solution to grant the necessary visibility and ensure a smooth transition
 - Clarity on the governance: what happens if the interpretation is not unanimously shared ?
