
NC FCA submitted in April 2014 by ENTSO-E

Preparatory work within ENTSO-E between mid 2013 – mid 2014: recommendations made on 7 key topics of the HAR which were presented to Florence Forum and to AESAG

Q3 2014: ENTSO-E starts **early** implementation of NC FCA on HAR in order to: •promote the development of liquid and competitive forward markets in a coordinated manner across Europe •provide the ability to hedge risk associated with cross-border electricity trading



Critical issues

Resource intensive process: need of all key TSOs experts with relevant time commitment to carry out high ENTSO-E workload (on top of national/regional tasks)

High level of coordination needed: among TSOs, NRAs (for approvals) and other stakeholders

Respect of time-plan and deadlines depends on smooth processes and efficient contribution of all involved parties, including ACER and NRAs

No off-the-shelf solutions: the most common principles/rules are not always the most suitable for all European borders and cables. Harmonisation involves Legal and financial issues





HAR public consultation I,

2 March – 30 March (4 weeks according to NC FCA)

Via ENTSO-E new consultation tool

Single point for consultation of 31 borders within the EU HAR main body developed by ENTSO-E while the annexes by relevant TSOs



HAR public consultation II,

Open questions also published by regions and by borders Comments, questions to be assessed by relevant parties ENTSO-E or relevant TSOs

Result to be published in due time HAR SAG will continue to meet
