BLOCK 1: RDIC ADMINISTRATION

TOP 6. Digitalising the Energy System - EU action plan

RDIC Chair, Head of Innovation Section and ENTSO-E Secretariat briefs RDIC members on Joint ENTSO-E and EU DSO Joint Task Force (JTF) ongoing work on project proposal and cooperation agreement. Members were briefed that Task Force continues to advance on the content of Digital Twin through description of challenges, use cases and speeding up for a shared view across TSOs community. Furthermore, members are informed that JTF will aim to produce preparatory input in the form of principles for smart indicators ahead of Copenhagen Infrastructure Forum. Finally, TF DIC Convener provides members an overview of TWIN EU project.
